


Start by printing this page, making sure you're printing it actual size to ensure you have the correct scale.

Use a ruler to check the scale of your print.



The Ring Method

This is the perfect method if you'd like to buy a ring for a gift, but you don't know the person's ring size and you don't want to ruin the surprise by asking them. Here's what you do.

- Get hold of a ring from their current collection of rings.
- Place the ring on one of these circles.
- The correct circle is the one which fits right against the ir edge of the ring (close your one eye for best results).
- If you don't get an exact fit, don't panic! With all the circles to choose from this is highly unlikely, give us the two closest sizes and we'll figure it out from

The Floss/String Method

This is probably the least accurate method, but if you really don't care for cutting out the paper sizer below, you can do the following:

- Simply cut a length of floss or string to wrap around the relevant finger and find the length that makes exactly one loop around.
- Measure the piece of floss or string, using the chart below for reference.

The Paper Sizer Method

If you enjoy cutting things out, then this method is the one for you. Just don't run with the scissors!

- Print and cut out the ring sizer. Cut the small slit that the hand is pointing to.
- Place the ring sizer comfortably around the finger by slipping the pointy end through the slit, numbers facing out.
- Secure the ring sizer by pulling the pointy end snugly around the finger like a belt,
- just enough for it to still be able to slide around - not too tight and not too loose.
- Your approximate ring size should be the number that appears where it says 'READ SIZE HERE'.

The "I've always fancied myself as a bit of a spy" Method

- Get hold of a ring to use as a gauge.
- Get a bar of soap and cut it in half.
